Choice Based Credit System Regulations

Title & Commencement: These regulations will be called the SKMU Regulations for CBCS and Continuous Assessment Grading Pattern (CAGP) for UG Programmes. These regulations shall come into force from the academic year 2017-18.

Choice Based Credit System is an instructional package developed to suit the needs of students to keep pace with the developments in higher education worldwide taking him/her out of isolated compartmentalized learning environment. The student in this system has considerable freedom in choosing courses and so making his / her own personalized programme/ bouquet in a cafeteria mode keeping in mind necessary requirements of a major course. Except for the compulsory and core courses of the subject of his / her major, he / she is free to choose courses of his /her choice. The programme is considered completed when the student cumulates the requisite number of successful credits (passed), i.e. at least 144 credits for an undergraduate degree in Honours Program and 124 credits in General Program.

Eligibility:

For Admission:

1. A pass in the Senior Secondary (+2) Examination (Academic Stream) conducted by Jharkhand Intermediate Academic Council or an examination accepted as equivalent thereto.
2. No student will be allowed to opt for Core Course in UG (Honours) program unless he/she secures a minimum of 45% marks in the concerned subject at the Senior Secondary (+2) Examination.
3. Students from science stream at the intermediate level (+2) can shift to Arts or Commerce faculty. They can opt for core course in UG (Honours) program in any subject in any faculty provided they secure a minimum of 45% marks in the aggregate.
4. Students from commerce stream at the intermediate level (+2) can shift to Arts faculty. They can opt for core course in UG (Honours) program in any subject in the faculty provided they secure a minimum of 45% marks in the aggregate.

Choosing Program Study Courses:

Under the Choice Based Credit System, each student of an undergraduate program will study the following courses:

1. **Core Course:** A course, which should compulsorily be studied by a candidate as a core requirement is termed as a Core course. In simple words, Core course may be considered a course in which a student prefers to do specialisation.
